## 2009 BREEDING CONTRACT for CHAPARRAL DGL

This contract is for the breeding of the above named mare and owner only and cannot be transferred without the permission of both Bonnie Ellis and an agent of Eagle Bluff Training Center.

This breeding must be used by the end of the breeding season for year 2009.

The breeding fee of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ is payable as follows:

1. A non-refundable deposit of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ will be paid in advance to reserve the breeding.
2. The balance of \$ \_\_\_\_\_ will be paid before semen is shipped or the mare is bred at Eagle Bluff Training Center. All checks will be made payable to Bonnie Ellis.
3. There will be a \$250 charge plus FedEx fee for each semen shipment. Payment must be made by credit card to Cedar Ridge Equine Clinic, Davenport, Iowa, (563) 386-8604, before collection is made.
4. There will be a handling charge of \$250 for every semen collection/shipment, payable to Eagle Bluff Training Center.
5. All semen shipments require 48 hour advance notice.

Any and all veterinary fees, including but not limited to ultrasound, vaginal cultures, vaccinations or other medical services determined to ensure the mare's welfare and successful breeding while in residence at Eagle Bluff Training Center will be paid via credit card by the mare owner to Cedar Ridge Equine Clinic, Davenport, Iowa, (563) 386-8604. The mare owner authorizes the agent(s) of Eagle Bluff Training Center to order any and all veterinary services deemed necessary to ensure a successful breeding of the mare.

All additional non-veterinary charges, including board and all other costs deemed necessary to the mare's well-being while at Eagle Bluff Training Center are to be paid by cash or check by the mare owner before the mare leaves Eagle Bluff Training Center.



The mare is required to have had a Coggins test within the preceding six months if she is to be bred on site. The negative Coggins certificate, dated no more than six months before the day the mare arrives at Eagle Bluff Training Center, must accompany the mare.

A health certificate no more than 15 days old must accompany the mare to Eagle Bluff Training Center if the mare is to be bred on site. The health certificate must list the dates of all vaccinations plus state the mare has been examined to be sound for breeding and is free of disease.

A return privilege for 2010 only is extended to mares that are pronounced barren after being bred or if the mare gives birth to a dead foal or a foal that fails to stand and suckle. A signed veterinary certificate stating the above must be sent to Eagle Bluff Training Center before the 2010 breeding will be allowed to be booked.

If, after breeding through three heat cycles, the mare fails to conceive using shipped semen, the mare owner will have the reproductive status of the mare reevaluated by a veterinarian. Once the reproductive status of the mare is known, the mare owner, Bonnie Ellis and an agent for Eagle Bluff Training Center will then jointly decide on one of the following four options:

1. Continue breeding.
2. Select a substitute mare and continue breeding.
3. If, after a continuous breeding attempt a successful pregnancy has not been achieved by Aug. 1, the mare owner may carry the breeding over to 2010 only. An additional fee of \$\_\_\_\_\_ shall apply.
4. The mare owner may send the mare to Eagle Bluff Training Center for reproductive analysis and to continue breeding at the center.

If none of the above options are chosen, the mare owner will forfeit all paid fees and deposits. There will be no refunds and all re-breeding rights will be forfeited. All rebreedings must be used by 2010 or be forfeited.

Mares that fail to conceive or produce a dead foal or a foal that fails to stand and suckle after being bred on a donated service fee may be rebred as per the above terms after paying the \$\_\_\_\_\_ booking fee plus all semen transport and handling fees. Rebreeding must be done in 2009 or be forfeited. A veterinarian certificate stating the mare is barren or the foal was born dead or died immediately after being born (failed to stand and suckle) must be sent to Eagle Bluff Training Center before the 2010 breeding will be allowed to be booked.

The mare owner agrees to notify Eagle Bluff Training Center by telephone, mail or e-mail when the mare has been declared by a veterinarian to be in foal.

Neither Bonnie Ellis, Eagle Bluff Training Center nor its members, agents or employees shall be liable for injury, death or disability suffered by the mare or foal at side, if any, from any cause whatsoever while in the custody of Eagle Bluff Training Center. By signature below, the mare owner specifically assents to such conditions and waives each and every claim for damages resulting from such injury, death or disability.
